## **Ecosystem Overview**

- ASEAN ~650 mill population. ~USD3.17 trill
   GDP (Statista, 2022)
- MSMEs represent more than 96% of all firms in the region (ASEAN, 2020)
- In 2018, estimated 5,800 startups across SEA (ASEAN, 2020)
- In 2021 alone, the region saw 21 unicorns, bringing its total to 40 unicorns, and counting (EDB, 2022)

**Diversity of MSMEs = Challenge to Support** 


### The Path Forward – Public Sector
